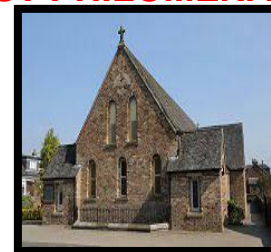



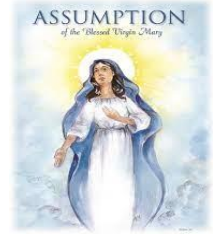
Margaret Burn's funeral was on Friday at Broxburn; unfortunately, we weren't able to publish this in last week's newsletter. May she rest in peace.
