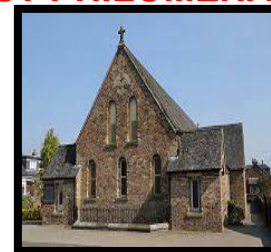

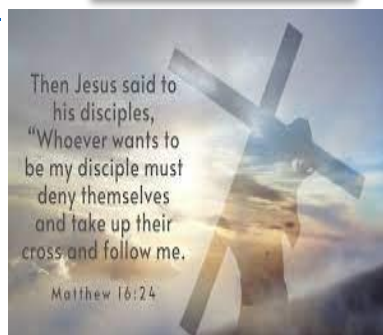

Family Mass -Broxburn

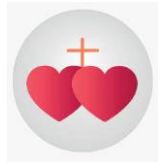
All welcome to join us for teas and coffee after our Family Mass this Sunday in Broxburn. Enjoy some home-baking and a cuppa and fun activities for the children.
