World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly – Sunday 28th July

The theme chosen by the Holy Father – “Do not cast me off in my old age” (cf. *Psalm 71:9*) – is meant to call attention to the fact that, sadly, loneliness is the bitter lot in life of many elderly people, so often the victims of the throw-away culture. In this year of preparation for the Jubilee, which the Holy Father wishes to be devoted to prayer, the theme of the World Day is taken from Psalm 71, the plea of an elderly person who reflects on the story of his friendship with God.
