Public Rosary & Candlelight Procession

Please join people from across the country to pray the Rosary in George Square, Glasgow, at 6:30pm on **Thursday 24 October** for the annual torchlight procession. It commemorates 57 years since the passing of the 1967 Abortion Act, which has led to the loss of more than 10 million lives in the UK. This is a solemn and prayerful event to pray for an end to abortion. After the Rosary, there is a procession to St Andrew's Cathedral where Mass will be celebrated by Canon David Wallace.

All Souls' Day -Archbishop Cushley will offer Holy Mass for the repose of all the faithful departed who have died in the Archdiocese in the last year, especially those buried at Mount Vernon Cemetery in Edinburgh. This will take place on All Souls' Day, **Saturday 2 November**, at 10:00am in the Cemetery Chapel at Mount Vernon Cemetery, 49 Mount Vernon Rd, Edinburgh, EH16 6JG.
