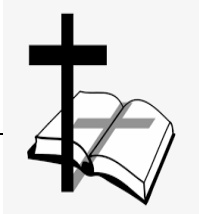

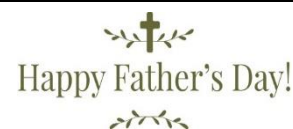

As you may be aware, the final and decisive vote on the Leadbeater Assisted Suicide Bill is now just 13 days away - on Friday 20 June. If just 28 MPs switch from supporting assisted suicide to opposing it, the Bill falls. Some have already switched, so this Bill can be defeated.
