Monday 28th June – Memorial, St Irenaeus, 2nd Century, friend of St John, the evangelist. Missionary to France. Defeated Gnosticism. Died a Martyr.

Tuesday 29th June – Feast of St Peter & Paul

Simon Peter – brother of Andrew, Galilean fisherman. Bishop of Antioch, then Rome, where he was martyred as leader of the 'Twelve'.

Paul – Dramatic conversion on road to Damascus. Great missionary and letter writer. Apostle who also died as a martyr in Rome.

Sat 3rd July – Feast of St Thomas – Apostle. Known as 'Doubting Thomas' – One of the 'Twelve'. Missionary to Kerala, India. Martyred at Chennai.
